Who can attend?

This will be a 2 unit course for seminary students who can register normally through the seminary office, but we also invite male pastors, missionaries, church ministry leaders, and aspiring seminarians to audit for \$100.

Course Description:

This course is designed to survey the geographical background of the Biblical records. Along with a literal, historical, grammatical study of the scripture, this course adds geographical and cultural information as a tool to understand the text. The course includes a regional study of the physical/historical geography of the Land of Israel and surrounding nations. Emphasis will be placed on the role each geographical region played in Biblical times. Visual aids and detailed maps will give you the opportunity to witness the Biblical land, people and culture, bringing the text alive.

Required for Class:

The Bible, Holman Bible Atlas, colored pencils.

Assignments:

Class attendance, read Holman Bible Atlas, 1 Paper (10 Pages), 2 Sermon Outlines, 10 Map tests.
